

## FUNDING OPPORTUNITY

BOY SCOUTS WORKING ON EAGLE SCOUT SERVICE PROJECTS AND GIRL SCOUTS WORKING ON THE GOLD AWARD

The Holle Family Foundation is pleased to offer Boy Scouts working on the rank of Eagle Scout and Girl Scouts working on the Gold Award an opportunity to secure funding in support of their service projects. To access the application, go to the Holle Foundation website at [www.hollefoundation.org](http://www.hollefoundation.org). The “*Scouting Service Project*” application will be under “*Opportunities*”.

- Boy Scout projects require an upload of the Eagle Scout Service Project Workbook with all approval signatures.
- Girl Scout projects require an upload of the project proposal packet with approval signatures. Our application questions mirror those in the project booklets so simply copy and paste.

The Holle Family Foundation wants to know how Scouts are serving Alabama communities. A final report is required which includes a completed project booklet or document along with a few photos upon completion of the project.

### Grant Details:

- Limited to Greater Alabama and Black Warrior Boy Scout Councils and The Girl Scouts of North Central Alabama.
- Suggested grant request is \$500. Larger amounts (up to \$1,000) may be requested for projects that represent a significant community impact.
- Grants must be used within 6 months.
- Projects must be completed:
  - Boy Scouts: 6 months before Boy Scout’s 18th birthday
  - Girl Scouts: September 30<sup>th</sup> of the graduating year of high school
- Projects must demonstrate leadership skills and reflect the principles of Scouting.
- Projects that meet a community or public need will stand out for approval

### Proposal Details:

- Must be submitted online through the [Holle Family Foundation website](http://www.hollefoundation.org).
- Must include a copy of the approved *Service Project Workbook* or *Project Proposal Packet*.
- Must include a letter of recommendation from a Scout Leader.

The applying Scout and Scoutmaster will be notified if the service project is approved for funding. For Boy Scout’s, checks will be made payable to both the Scout and Scoutmaster. For Girl Scout’s, funds will be administered through Girl Scout of North Central Alabama.
